



TEAM COACH

Description of Role:

- Supports our Spring League program by teaching field hockey skills to our players

Primary Responsibilities:

- Receives Club training plans and implements with team
- Leads team in practices and games
- Provides feedback to players and helps them master skills
- Supervises and provides direction to Junior Coach
- If required, provides feedback to Club regarding player-related issues

Time Commitment:

- March – June during the Spring League season
- Must be available for team practices and games (approximately 2-4 hours each week)
- Coaching clinics may be held pre-season
- Required to attend Manager and Coaches' meeting at the start of the season

Skill Requirements:

- Knowledge of field hockey is an asset but not required
- Strong communication skills
- Ability to relate to and work well with children
- Ability to lead by example with good behaviour towards umpires, opposition and supporters
